



Conditions of entry into Tunisia (August 2021)

In accordance with the latest communiqué of Tunisian authorities, here are the conditions of entry in Tunisia:

1. You are vaccinated:

- Present a negative RT-PCR test bearing a “QR code”, not exceeding 72 hours at check-in at the airport of departure. This RT-PCR certificate must be presented upon arrival.
- Undergo a 10-day self-containment period from the date of arrival in Tunisia.
- Comply with the random rapid antigenic test upon arrival if selected. If the test is positive, you will be transferred to a health isolation center at your own expense.
- Fill in the mandatory information requested on the website: <https://app.e7mi.tn>, then print and sign the two documents generated by the application and hand them to the health services at the point of arrival at the airport.

2. You are not vaccinated:

- Present a negative RT-PCR test with a “QR code” not more than 72 hours old at check-in at the airport of departure.
This RT-PCR certificate must be presented to health services upon arrival.
- Comply with the random rapid antigenic test upon arrival if selected. If the test is positive, you will be sent to a health isolation center at your own expense.
- Fill in the mandatory information requested on the website: <https://app.e7mi.tn>, then print and sign the two documents generated by the application and hand them to the health services upon arrival at the airport.
Submit to the mandatory confinement for a period of 10 days from the date of arrival in Tunisia in one of the hotels authorized to accommodate the confined, at your expense, with the obligation to present at check-in at the airport of departure the document confirming the reservation and payment (Voucher).
- Perform a second RT-PCR test between the 7th and 10th day of the mandatory confinement, at your expense. If the test result is negative, you will be allowed to lift the mandatory confinement, while committing to respect the required sanitary preventive measures.

Unaccompanied minors (under 18 years of age) or minors accompanying persons vaccinated against COVID-19 are exempt from mandatory containment.
